Rules and Regulations

- Priority for acceptance will be given to past participants in good standing. Acceptance to a previous Festival is no guarantee, expressed or implied that the artist will be accepted to any subsequent Festival.
- **To secure a table at the festival, application, photos, and payment must ALL be submitted – no exceptions.**
- The event fee is \$150. This includes one 8'x30" table, two chairs, and promotion of the event by organizers.
- **All displays must fit on or beneath the provided table. Items under the table must be hidden by a full length table cloth.** No other displays will be allowed without prior approval of the Festival Organizers.
- Setup is 7am-9am Saturday morning. Breakdown is 4pm-6pm Sunday. Artists must be present with fully stocked tables during hours the Festival is open to the public. Late setups and early breakdowns are not permitted.
- The Festival Organizer will determine the location of all participants within the facility. Artists may request locations within the facility that may have walls, corners or electrical service, however there is no guarantee that any particular space will be available and the final decision on location of each participant is within the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizers.
- If you have paid for a space and need to cancel before the festival, please contact the festival organizer as soon as possible. Refunds will be offered until Oct 11th, less a \$25 administration fee.
- The primary focus of the show is pottery and all vendors must have pottery and related items as their main focus. All items must be hand-crafted. If you are a potter who works in another medium, you may also sell that work, however pottery should be the main focus. Exceptions may be made by organizers with prior approval.
- Food and beverages will be available for purchase. You may also bring your own food and beverage for personal consumption. Alcohol is not allowed.
- Pets are not allowed at this event. Only service animals that comply with applicable laws will be allowed.
- Artists are responsible for their own insurance and the collection and reporting of any applicable taxes including Florida sales tax. All pertinent information – directions, parking info, etc. will be sent via email about a week before the show. Please contact organizers if you have questions.
- Event applicants/artists agree to allow images included with their application or video/photos taken at the event to be used for publicity or advertising.
- The Orlando Pottery Festival seeks to create an inclusive and diverse environment free from discrimination of any kind, irrespective of gender, age, ethnicity, identity, disability, sexual orientation or other forms of diversity. Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated. Aggressive behavior towards participants, organizers, vendors or the public will also not be tolerated. This includes harassing, abusive or threatening language or physical assault. Organizers reserve the right to remove any participant who violates this policy in their sole & absolute discretion.
- As important as the inclusion of talented artists is to the festival, we do not lose sight of the need for artists who are cooperative, positive, and easy for organizers and other participants to work with. Difficult artists may be excluded from future events.
