



The Orlando Pottery Festival is a privately produced biannual event providing the public the opportunity to browse and purchase work from a wide range of local ceramic artists. Our aim is to provide a positive environment for ceramic artists of varying styles and experience levels to show and sell their work. *The Orlando Pottery Festival is not affiliated with any public or private pottery or art studios.*

2026 Spring Market Rules and Information

- Priority for acceptance will be given to past participants in good standing. Acceptance to a previous Festival is no guarantee, expressed or implied that the artist will be accepted to any subsequent Festival.
- **To secure a table at the festival, application, photos, and payment must ALL be submitted – no exceptions.**
- **Table sharing is not permitted**, though exceptions may be granted by the organizers. There shall be one business/artist per table. No table shall have more than 2 representatives/sellers due to space constraints.
- The event fees include one table (6 or 8 ft x 30"), two chairs, and promotion of the event by organizers.
\$75.00 - 8' x 30" table, standard \$60.00 - 6' x 30" table (limited availability)
- **All displays must fit on or beneath the provided table. Items under the table must be hidden by a full length tablecloth.** No other displays will be allowed without prior approval of the Festival Organizers.
- Setup is 7am-8:45am Saturday morning. Breakdown is at 5pm. Artists must be present with fully stocked tables during the hours that the Festival is open to the public. Late setups and early breakdowns are not permitted.
- The Festival Organizer will determine the location of all participants within the facility. Artists may request locations within the facility that may have walls, corners or electrical service, however there is no guarantee that any particular space will be available, and the final decision on location of each participant is within the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizers.
- If you have paid for a space and need to cancel before the festival, please contact the festival organizer as soon as possible. Refunds will be offered until March 11th, less a \$25 administration fee. No refunds after this date.
- The primary focus of the show is pottery, and all vendors must have pottery and related items as their primary focus. All items must be handcrafted. If you are a potter who works in another medium, you may also sell that work; however, pottery should be the primary focus. Exceptions may be made by organizers with prior approval.
- Food and beverages will be available for purchase. You may also bring your own food and beverage for personal consumption. Alcohol is not allowed.
- Pets are not allowed at this event. Only service animals that comply with applicable laws will be allowed.
- Artists are responsible for their own insurance and the collection and reporting of any applicable taxes including Florida sales tax.
- All pertinent information – directions, parking info, etc. will be sent via email about a week before the show. Please contact organizers if you have any questions.
- Event applicants/artists agree to allow images included with their application or video/photos taken at the event to be used for publicity or advertising.
- The Orlando Pottery Festival seeks to create an inclusive and diverse environment free from discrimination of any kind, irrespective of gender, age, ethnicity, identity, disability, sexual orientation or other forms of diversity. Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated. Aggressive behavior towards participants, organizers, vendors, or the public will also not be tolerated. This includes harassing, abusive or threatening language or physical assault. Organizers reserve the right to remove any participant who violates this policy in their sole & absolute discretion.
- As important as the inclusion of talented artists is to the festival, we do not lose sight of the need for artists who are cooperative, positive, and easy for organizers and other participants to work with. Difficult artists may be excluded from future events.
